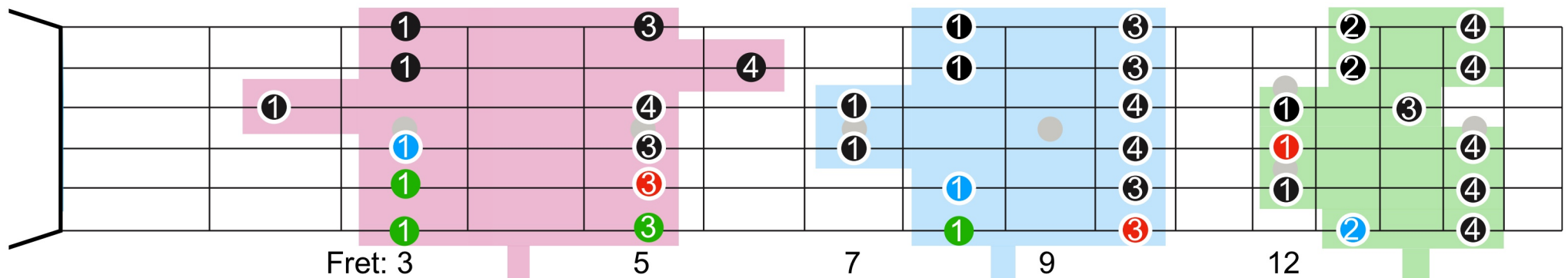


Finding Other Patterns

If you take the "odd shape" (red highlights) and look at it's basic shape (white circled) you will find a new possible pattern that can be used also in 6th string root. If You analyse this pattern, it is nothing more than the Major Shape with the Root ● in the 5th string.

If you prefer to think in these two patterns, in addition with the two minor ones seen before (these can also be though as minor, using the ● notes as guide), notice that then we'll have a different "odd one" (green highlight).



Patterns seen before:

2 Minors/2 Majors/1 Odd

Root with 1st Finger

Root with 2nd Finger

ODD ONE

Major Root in the 5th String

Major Root in the 6th String

As seen here:

4 Minors/1 Odd

2 Roots with 1st Finger

2 Roots with 3rd Finger

Minor Root with 3rd Finger in the 5th String

Minor Root with 3rd Finger in the 6th String

(new) ODD ONE
